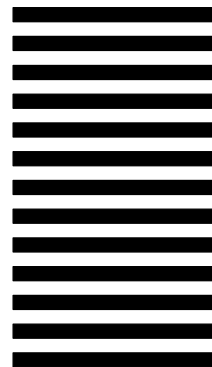

JUNK PICK UP DAY IS SATURDAY, MAY 8, 2004

Latex Paint Disposal

Remove the lid. Set can in a well-ventilated area until paint is dried. Set it out for collection next to your trash with the lid off. You may place kitty litter in the paint to help it dry faster.

Oil-Based Paint Disposal. Oil-based paint is considered household hazardous waste. You may take oil-based paint and other qualifying items to the HazBin.

The HazBin is located at 7501 Grade Lane about one quarter mile from the Outer Loop. It is open Wednesdays and Saturdays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. For more information about HazBin please call 574-7336.

Refrigerator Disposal

Please have the freon from a refrigerator removed by a registered technician before you put it out for junk pick up. When you put the refrigerator out for pick-up please leave the technician's official sticker on the refrigerator to verify freon removal by a certified technician.

SANITATION PICK-UP SCHEDULE FOR THE REMAINDER OF 2004

JUNK PICK UP DAY, SATURDAY, MAY 8, 2004. Have junk to the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. for pickup on this day.

MEMORIAL DAY, MONDAY, MAY 31, 2004. There will be no collections on Memorial Day, May 31. Rumpke will begin service for the week on Tuesday, June 1 by servicing those routes normally serviced on Monday. All services for this week will be delayed by one day. Therefore, the regular Tuesday pick-up will be on Wednesday and the Friday pick-up will be on Saturday.

INDEPENDENCE DAY, SUNDAY, JULY 4, 2004. Since Independence Day is on Sunday, the holiday does not affect our collection schedule for this week. Rumpke will provide regularly scheduled services Monday through Friday.

LABOR DAY, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2004. There will be no collections on Labor Day, September 6. As above on Memorial Day, all services for this week will be delayed by one day. The Tuesday pick-up will be on Wednesday and the Friday pick-up will be on Saturday.

THANKSGIVING DAY, THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2004. Rumpke will provide regularly scheduled services on Tuesday, November 23. There will be no collections on Thursday, November 25. The Friday pick-up will be on Saturday.

CHRISTMAS DAY, SATURDAY, DECEMBER 25, 2004. Since Christmas is on Saturday, the holiday does not affect our collection schedule for this week. Rumpke will provide regularly scheduled services on Tuesday and Friday of this week.

NEW ORDINANCE

The Hurstbourne City Commission is continually receiving complaints from residents, resulting from pet owners not respecting their neighbors or the City's property. They are allowing their pets to "do their business" anywhere within the City and not removing the waste.

After years of pleading with these violators but to no avail, the Commission passed the following ordinance on March 9, 2004: "An Ordinance Relating to the Control of Dogs and Removal of Dog Feces within the City and Providing Penalties for the Violation of the Provision Set Forth."

Effective immediately, anyone walking their dog off their property must carry, in plain sight, material to pick up and properly dispose of their pet's feces. Violators of this ordinance are subject to a \$100 fine. We sincerely hope that enforcement of this ordinance will not be necessary.
