Dear Hurstbourne Residents,

We're thrilled to have the ISCO Championship return to Hurstbourne Country Club this July. This is Kentucky's annual PGA TOUR event, and it is an honor to shine a global spotlight on Hurstbourne Country Club and our great city.

We want to keep you aware of the event and plans to handle traffic, parking, ticket purchases and what you can expect during the week of the tournament.

- The dates for the ISCO Championship are Thursday, July 9 – Sunday, July 12, 2026. Private practice rounds closed to the public will be held Monday, July 6 – Wednesday, July 8. Tickets to the event can be purchased on the tournament's website (iscochampionship.com), where you can also find answers to frequently asked questions. Attendees will utilize a bus shuttling system to enter the tournament from the general parking lot at UofL's Shelby Campus.

Parking regulations will be modified in the city from Monday, July 6 to Sunday, July 12 to monitor unauthorized entry into the event and to prevent overcrowding of our streets. This will include clearly identified sections of city streets where street parking will be prohibited and strictly enforced. A parking permit system will be implemented by the city during the week of July 6 to accommodate residents who wish to invite guests to their homes for the event and need to use street parking (where allowed). More details on this system will be provided in future correspondence, well ahead of the tournament.

The Mayor, Commissioners, and City Administrator have been actively engaged with both the Club and the ISCO Championship staff to ensure residents are fully informed of the tournament's impact. We are looking forward to a successful week.

The city will update our website with a landing page that will include a FAQ, copies of each correspondence, and other important information regarding the tournament as it becomes available.
