Dear Hurstbourne Residents,

The ISCO Championship, Kentucky's annual PGA TOUR event, is just around the corner—running from Monday, July 6 through Sunday, July 12. To help manage traffic and prevent long-term street parking during the tournament, the city will be using a temporary parking permit system that week.

Here's what you need to know:

Street Parking Rules:

Hurstbourne's Code of Ordinances (Chapter 72) already prohibits street parking unless your garage and driveway are full. We ask all residents to continue following this rule throughout the tournament.

For Extra Parking

If you're expecting more guests than your driveway can handle, you can pick up a maximum of five parking permits per household. These permits allow for temporary street parking between July 6–12.

Permits must be displayed on the rearview mirror, facing forward. Vehicles parked on the street without a visible permit during that week will be towed at the owner's expense.

How to Get Your Permits:

Permits will be available for pickup M-F at City Hall (200 Whittington Parkway) from Monday, June 15 through Thursday, July 2, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Please bring your driver's license—you'll need to sign for your permits.

Important Notes:

Some streets will be marked as No Parking zones due to shuttle routes and tournament operations. Please obey posted signs.

Event Access & Parking:

The only entrance to the tournament is at the main gate near the intersection of Nottingham and Leesgate. Security will be monitoring the perimeter of the golf course and will not permit access to the event except at the main gate. Daily wrist bands will be distributed at the entrance gate. General parking for attendees will be at Shelby Campus with shuttle service provided. Residents or guests may not enter the course through private yards.
